Maria Curie-Skłodowska was awarded the **Nobel Prize** twice:

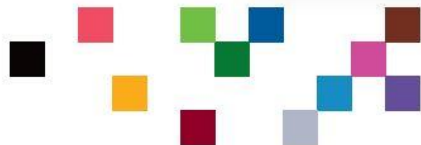
- in the field of **physics** in **1903** received together with her husband, Pierre Curie, and Henri Becquerel for their research on **radioactivity**
- in the field of **chemistry** in **1911** for development of chemistry due to the discovery of **polonium and radium** in addition to the examination of metallic radium and its chemical compounds

Lublin is a city with a **700-year history** abounding in events that changed Poland and Europe. The historical heritage of Lublin, suffused with **Jagiellonian tradition**, the combination of nations, cultures and religions resulted in the creation of Lublin's **magical atmosphere** that is instantly felt and experienced. 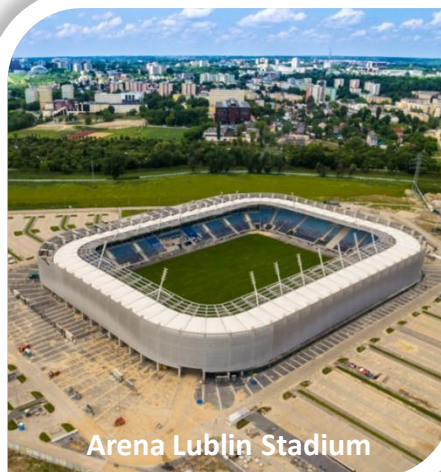

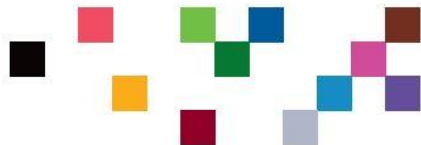

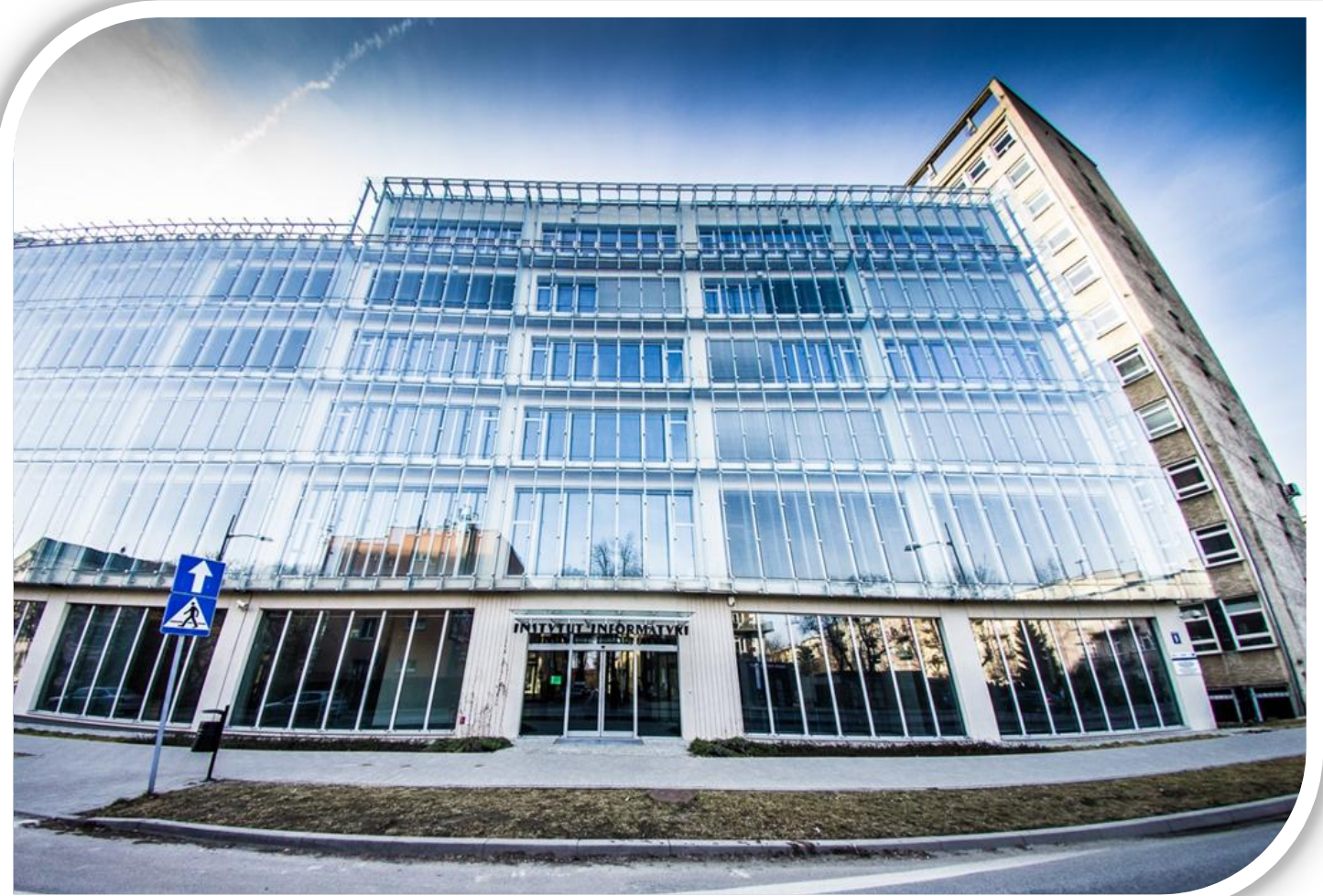
About University

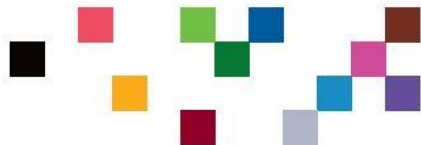

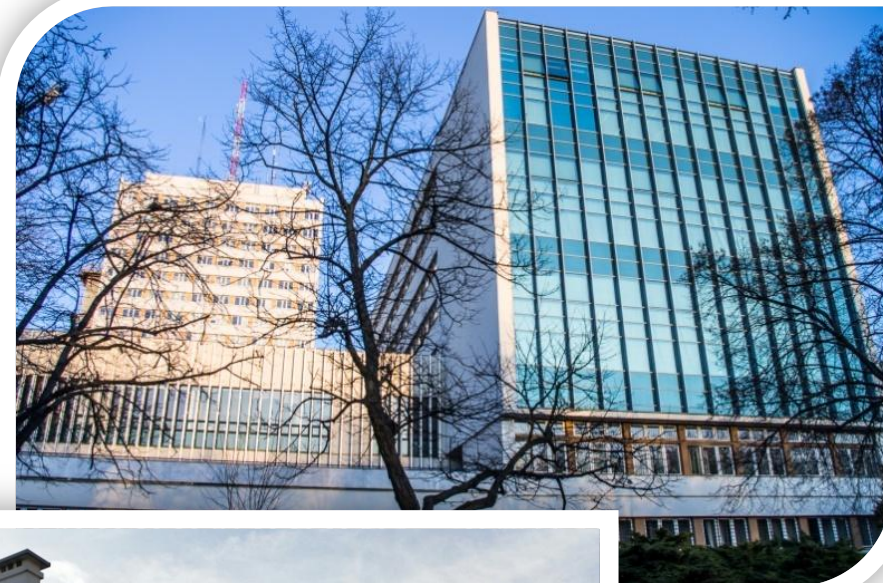

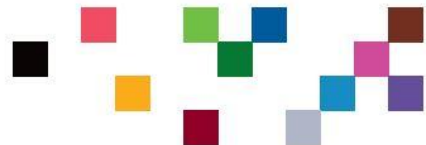


Research & development



Centre for Functional Nanomaterials

Research, along with education, constitutes the most important sphere of university activity. UMCS conducts research at eleven Faculties and at the University's interdisciplinary centers. These investigations bring numerous remarkable achievements and are the foundation for scholarly development of the academic staff. The range of research subjects is extremely wide: scholars conduct work on groundbreaking inventions in life and health sciences, develop new diagnostic and treatment methods, construct innovative materials or equipment, analyze physicochemical, economic, social and cultural processes in the world, and conduct thorough observations of the environment and climatic changes and field studies.

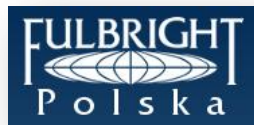


International cooperation

Cooperation with business sector

The Knowledge and Technology Transfer Centre

The Knowledge and Technology Transfer Centre is responsible for facilitation and practical application of research results, and for finding business entities willing to cooperate in the form of research or training. It supports the development of cooperation with the local environment, coordinates the carrying out of commissioned research, and is concerned with intellectual property protection and commercialization of R&D results.

To promote offer UMCS **participates in fairs and conferences, organizes meetings with representatives of entrepreneur organizations, and directly contacts the interested businesses.** The university is a member of multiple clusters including: Lublin EcoEnergy Cluster, Biotechnology Cluster and the Eastern Cluster ICT. A number of research and development cooperation contracts have recently been signed with the largest Polish companies and employer associations.



Poland's Most International University

Maria Curie-Skłodowska University was ranked first by the Perspektywy Education Foundation in their latest report “International students in Poland 2017” which explores the current internationalization trends in higher education in Poland.

UMCS achieved the top position in terms of “internationalization of universities” with the highest internalization rate of 6.72%.



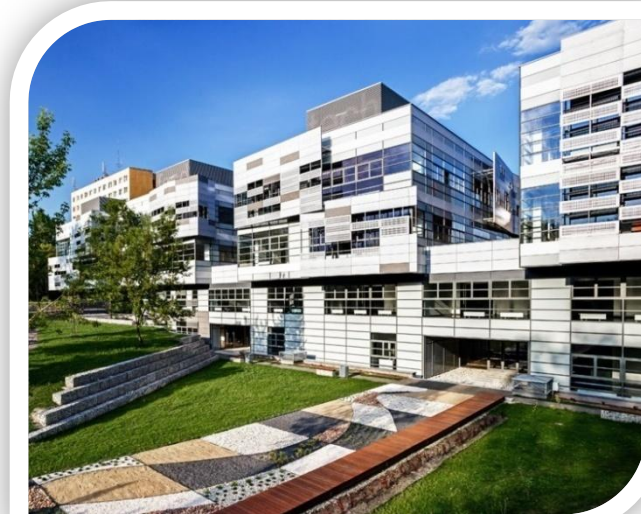

Ecotech – Complex

The end of 2015 brought completion of Analytical Center for Technologically Advanced Environmentally Friendly Research (ECOTECH COMPLEX).

Its mission is to create unique conditions for scientific research and provision of research services for industry on a world-class level in the areas described as: BIO-MED, AGRO, ECO, FOOD. The Center has 14 laboratories with an area of 2600 m² and so-called “clean room” for research which require the highest standards of cleanliness.



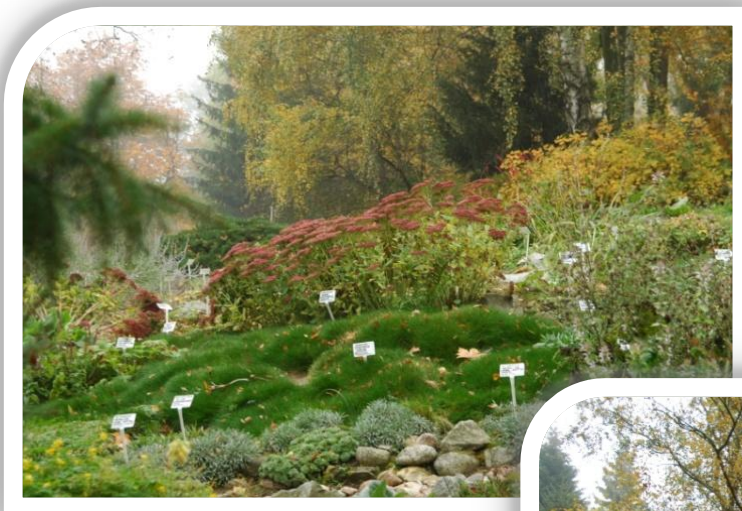

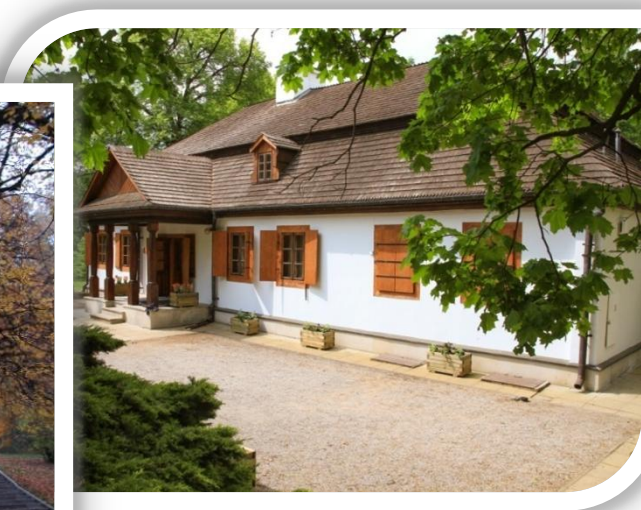
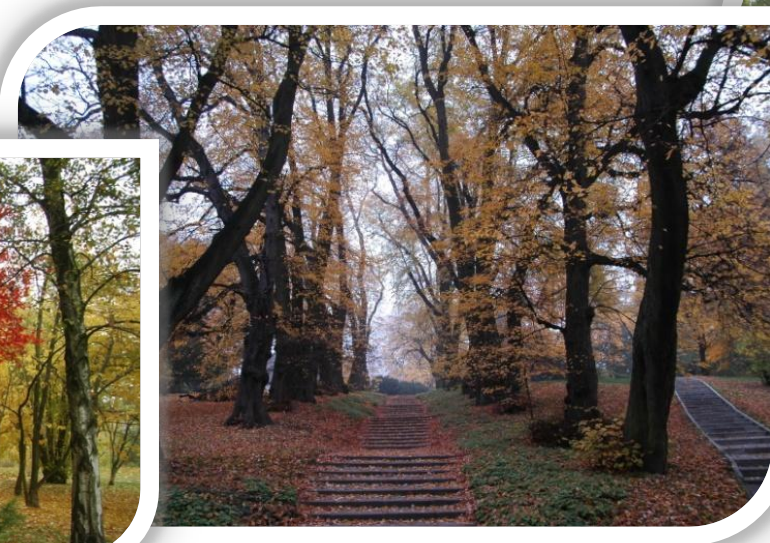
The UMCS Botanical Garden

Established in 1965, the UMCS Botanical garden was made available for public sightseeing purposes in 1974.

The main task of this scientific-didactic unit is active protection of **7000 endangered species** of plants. However, the garden is also a **place of leisure and recreation** for both inhabitants of Lublin and tourists.



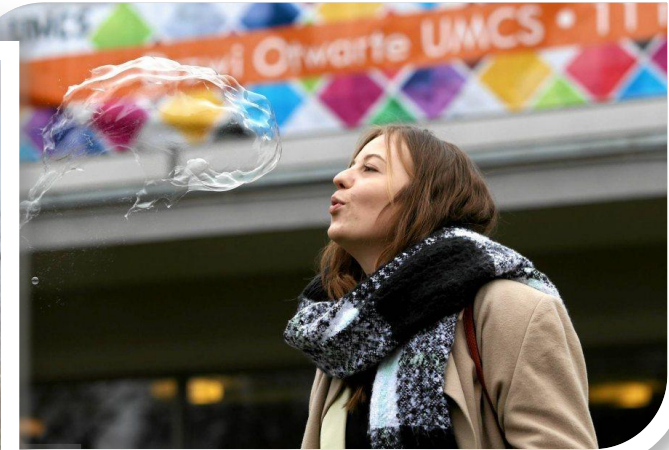
A place of interest is the **reconstructed noblemen's mansion** – Kościuszko Manor House (dated 2nd half of the 18th c.), connected with the family of national hero Tadeusz Kościuszko.

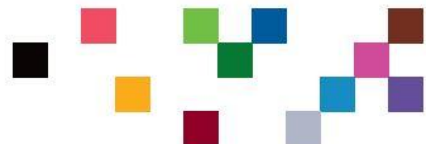


- Hundreds of players, over **40** sports sections i **9** league teams.
