Psychosocial factors of "second career" of former military pilots.

Dissertation takes the issue of "second career" of former military pilots in the areas such as: employment history and work experience, social and professional role, acquired competences and professional success. This career is considered in the context of selected psychosocial factors.

Diagnostic survey method was applied in the research, using techniques and tools such as: questionnaire prepared by the author (AKA), Self-Esteem Scale (SES), Proactive Personality Scale (PPS) - in the author's adaptation and Hope for Success Questionnaire (KNS).

The research have been carried out on former military pilots.

When analyzing the main issue, the whole discussion is divided into seven chapters. The first three chapters are theoretical and include characteristics of military pilot profession and changes in military aviation after 1999, discussion on career and its theories, also characteristics of selected psychosocial factors affecting the course of the respondents' "second career". The fourth chapter concerns the methodological issues and the other two contain the diagnosis "second career" of former military pilots and selected psychosocial factors: self-esteem, proactivity and hope for success. In the final part of dissertation main thesis was verified and conclusions were drawn.
