## SUMMARY OF PROFESSIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

### **I. The directions of research before the habilitation**

I was born on 5 November 1951 in Stalowa Wola. In 1969, after completion of the 2nd Secondary School in Rzeszów, I passed the entrance exams to the Faculty of Law and Administration of the Marie Curie-Skłodowska University (UMCS) in Lublin and I was admitted to the first year of studies at the Faculty of Law and Administration, a Branch of the UMCS in Rzeszów, and I graduated in 1974. During the studies, from 1969 to 1972, I was the President of the Legal Student Society at the Faculty and I participated actively in its work until my graduation.

After graduating, from 1 October 1974 I was employed as a research and technical assistant in the Branch of UMCS in Rzeszów. From 1 October 1975, I was employed as an assistant, and from 1 October 1977, as a senior assistant at the Department of Legal and Constitutional Sciences, headed by Professor J. Chwistek. In turn, from 1 October 1978, I was employed on the same position at the Department of History, Theory of State and Law, and Political Sciences, headed by Professor T. Opas. I was a senior assistant to 30 November 1981, and from 1 December 1981, I was employed as an assistant professor.

In the period from 1 October 1978 to 30 June 1979, I took a scientific internship at the Polish Institute of International Affairs in Warsaw, headed by Professor J. Symonides and Professor R. Bierzanek.

I was awarded a degree of the doctor of legal sciences on 25 November 1981 following a defence of my dissertation on 22 October 1981 on *Charakter prawnomiędzynarodowy Brytyjskiej Wspólnoty Narodów* [*The Nature under International Law of the British*

*Commonwealth*]. The dissertation supervisor was Professor L. Antonowicz. The reviewers were Professor L. Gelberg and Professor J. Z Pietraś.

The subject of my scientific interests after obtaining the degree of the doctor of legal sciences was the issue of the State in terms of international law, especially in relation to its subjectivity, for which it is necessary to have such elements as: a permanent population, a defined territory, the government and the ability to make relations with other States. In total I published seven articles, one chapter in the collective work and two monographic brochures before my habilitation.

The interest in international recognition resulted in the dissertation on “*Uznanie rządu w prawie międzynarodowym*” [“*Recognition of the Government in International Law*”]. In the dissertation, I presented the institution of the international recognition of the government, which is a quite frequent practice in international relations in various circumstances and is one of the most complex and controversial institutions of international law. The aim of this work was therefore to review the practices and analyse applicable international law in this field. I assumed that in the absence of complete legal provisions, an important element of my research should be primarily the international practice of recognising governments, which, according to the work, is not uniform. My task was to present a number of problems related to the answer to the questions: 1) what the significance of the government’s recognition in international law is, 2) whether recognition of the government is a legal or a political act, 3) what criteria are required for the government’s recognition or refusal to recognise it, 4) whether international law sets a requirement for the democratic legitimacy of the government,

5) what the current trends for the recognition of governments by international organizations are.

## **II. Directions of research following the habilitation**

On 18 November 1998, a habilitation colloquium was held based on the dissertation *Uznanie rządu w prawie międzynarodowym [Recognition of the Government in International Law]* (published by the UMCS, Lublin 1997). The reviewers in the habilitation procedure were: Professor L. Antonowicz, Professor A. Wasilkowski, Professor J. Tyranowski. On the same day, the Faculty Council adopted a resolution to award me with a degree of the habilitated doctor of legal sciences in international law. The Central Board for Academic Degrees and Titles endorsed the resolution of the Faculty Council on 22 February 1999.

Consequently, from 1 April 1999 I was employed as an assistant professor with the degree of the habilitated doctor at the Department of Public Law, headed by Professor E. Ura, and then on 1 April 2000 I took the position of the Head of the Department of International Law and the European Communities. On 1 July 2001, in accordance with the resolution of the Senate, I was nominated for the post of an extraordinary professor of the UMCS in Lublin and after the establishment of the University of Rzeszów, from 1 October 2001, I was employed as an extraordinary professor at the university and I have worked there ever since.

After obtaining the degree of the habilitated doctor my scientific interest focused mainly on issues related to the State's status in international law. My research can be divided into two streams.

I. The first of these is related to the continuation of interest in the institution of international recognition, with an extension of existing research findings on the problem of the recognition of the State. My interest in this field grew in connection with the breakdown of the USSR and Yugoslavia, which resulted in the creation of many new States, most of which required recognition by other States. In this respect, the practice of European countries showed that in the context of the analysis of the reasons justifying recognition apart from classical prerequisites (i.e. territory, population and effective authorities) additional prerequisites may be considered, including respect for human rights or the rights of minorities. The introduction of "democratisation" of the world political system, in guidelines adopted in 1991 by the contemporary countries of the European Communities on the recognition of new countries in Eastern Europe and the USSR, marked the evolution of the institution of the State's

recognition, particularly in European international law. The trend of democratic legitimacy was also reflected in the practice of the recognition of Governments which arose in an unconstitutional way.

Based on the analysis of using the institutions of State recognition it can be also noted that the greatest controversy is raised by this institution in relation to States arising by the way of secession. In this case, there is a problem of reconciling the principle of self-determination with the principle of territorial integrity of the State, exemplified by Kosovo, Abkhazia and Ossetia, Nagorno-Karabakh, the Pridnestrovian Moldavian Republic and entities emerging in Eastern Ukraine – the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic. Also, determining the international legal status of Crimea is still problematic. This direction of research resulted in the articles:

As a continuation of my interests, I also focused on the issue of international protection of human rights. In this area, I took a particular interest in issues related to the protection realised in the Council of Europe, mainly in the order of the European Convention on Human Rights, which occupies a special place in the system of human rights protection established within this organisation. States joining the CE have to accede to the Convention and to submit to the jurisdiction of the European Court of Human Rights which resolves individual complaints on the breach by the State of the rights guaranteed by the Convention. The State must implement the judgement of the ECHR in its internal legal system and the Committee of Ministers of the CE watches its implementation. The ECHR system constructed in this way influences national legal orders and aims to achieve effective protection of the human rights in the State. This issue was the subject of the analysis contained in the article *Europejski system ochrony praw człowieka a Polska [European System of Human Rights Protection and Poland]*, ed. E. Dynia, Cz. P. liberty. Human rights are also connected with issues of transplantation, associated with the use of modern medical technology which help, prolong or facilitate lives of people affected by heavy ailments. Progress in the development of transplantology indicates that transplants may soon become an increasingly used method of therapy; it should be noted, however, that it is a threat at the same time. It poses a threat, like other modern therapeutic methods, of violating human dignity or of objectifying the human being. Issues related to transplantation of human organs have become very significant and therefore the right to physical integrity of the human being, as a separate human right, has been increasingly underlined. This evolutionary creation of international standards is an expression of the desire to establish clear legal rules relating to the protection of human rights as a subject of modern medicine, including transplantology. The development of transplantology causes a need to extend and specify further the regulations associated with it. In the following articles the issue of human rights was extended also to issues of citizenship, particularly the citizenship of the European Union, minorities and refugees. II. The second research direction, which was not previously a subject of my interest, includes issues related to the European integration, international criminal law and international aviation and space law.

My interest in European integration related to the prospect of accession of Poland to the European Union. As lawyers specializing in international law had for long had an interest in widely understood process of European integration which concerns not only the European Communities / European Union but also other integration organizations, I presumed that this issue was of particular importance in the context of the accession of Poland to the EU. In terms of legal sciences, the European integration affects various problems. It is because the EU law regulates almost all areas of law and economic and social life. From the start of the process of the European integration, the legal systems of the Member States were under the significant influence of the EU law. As a result, there was a phenomenon called Europeanisation of different areas of national law, which was the result of the integration processes.

Isolating European law as an independent field of study led to an increasing interest of the Polish doctrine in the EU law, in both institutional and material aspect. The issues related to this topic are analysed from the point of view of different areas of law, as since the inclusion in the integrative structures, regional and European rules have become part of the Polish internal system. Various areas of law, including international law, identifies separate phenomena that are examined by these fields of study in the European context, discuss issues related to the integration process to understand better its legal nature and difficult problems in operation of the two systems of positive law in force in the territory of one Member State. Research in international law is also reflected in my publications. It was discussed in three, updated and extended, monographs: *Integracja europejska [European Integration]*. ### III. Research plans

The addressed research topic resulted in publishing of a monograph entitled *Uznanie państwa w prawie międzynarodowym [Recognition of the State in International Law]* gives a further perspective of the scientific exploration. This is since the institution of the international recognition still plays an important role in shaping the international community and is an important factor for the normalization of international relations. It concerns newly established States. To enable a State a full participation in international relations, it must be recognised by the international community. The ability of entering in relations with other States is both an

aspect of existence of a given State as well as of the importance assigned to its recognition by other States. In practice of international relations, the recognition of a State occurs in different circumstances. Although it seemed that because of creating relatively stable international community, this institution was gradually losing its importance, the disintegration of the Soviet Union and Yugoslavia and, consequently, a rise of many new States showed that the problems related to the recognition of new States may appear anew at any time. In recent years, they concerned e.g. Kosovo and are still current in the event of States generated at the beginning of the 1990s, like Abkhazia and Ossetia, Nagorno-Karabakh, the Pridnestrovian Moldavian Republic and entities emerging in Eastern Ukraine – the Donetsk People's Republic and the Luhansk People's Republic. Determining the international legal status of Palestine and Crimea remains problematic. These examples confirm that the institution of recognition of the State is still valid.
