University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest (Romania) in partnership with the the Agence Universitaire de la Francophonie (Romania), S.C. Avantera srl (Romania), University of Ruse "Angel Kanchev" (Bulgaria), Technical University of Kosice (Slovakia) and Maria Curie-Skłodowska University of Lublin (Poland) started the "InoLearn4BEEs" project, on November 2017, under ERASMUS + programme, 2014-2020.

Through an international partnership between RO, BG, SK, and PL, the project "InoLearn4BEEs" envisages an innovative architecture to step up changes in educating Business, Engineering and Entrepreneurship (BEE) students based on a fruitful cooperation between universities and different industries.

The "InoLearn4BEEs" project induces innovation changes through a set of interconnected activities which bring in the center of innovation, teachers and experts from four European countries, students and teachers from cross-disciplinary fields of education (Business, Engineering and Entrepreneurship areas), and key stakeholders from local business sector, civil society, public administration and/or governmental entities.

The project runs for 30 months and includes:

- ✚ Transform existing teacher-centred culture into students-centred learning approach used in Business, Engineering & Entrepreneurship (BEE) education areas and curricula, in a multicultural context of Romania, Bulgaria, Slovakia, and Poland.

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- ✚ Stimulate and enhance the digital skills and critical thinking in interdisciplinary and intercultural approach, by engaging students in Business, Engineering & Entrepreneurship (BEE) education from Romania, Bulgaria, Slovakia, and Poland.
 - ✚ Organizing 4 events to disseminate and multiply the project results (Slovenia, Romania, Bulgaria and Poland) with a group of 150 participants, spreading out and multiplying the results and benefits by ensuring the widest possible dissemination of project outputs and outcomes.

The effects of "InoLearn4BEEs" will be the virtual integration of innovative learning environment that incorporates ICT-tools, giving more opportunities for interactive learning, students becoming able to resolve cross-disciplinary problems, and to understand multicultural challenges and views.
