Description of activities	Field excavation, documentation of archaeological situations on various salvage excavations in the region of Eastern Bohemia. The main excavation activity will be the excavation in connection with the construction of the section of highway D11 between Hradec Králové and Jaroměř. This section of highway runs through the area that was densely inhabited in since prehistory. It promises numerous and interesting archaeological finds. The participation on field excavations will be eventually complemented by activities connected with post-excavation processing of archaeological finds in archaeological laboratory at the University of Hradec Králové.
