- The student recognizes the problems related to the educational needs of deaf and hearingimpaired students, plan and implement educational activities at the first stage of education.
- The student is acquainted with methods, forms, means of education and rehabilitation of students with hearing impairment and is able to verify the effects of conducted educational and rehabilitation activities.
- The student gains awareness of undertaking individual and team educational and rehabilitation activities and recognizes the need to release individual potential and social resources of students.
- The student learns to position him/herself in debates.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Determinants of the process of educating children with hearing impairment.

Elements of audiology. Classifications of hearing damage.

Pedagogical typology of hearing damage and people affected by it.

Language and speech acquisition by hearing impaired children.

Diagnosis of the educational needs of deaf and hard of hearing students.

Auditory and language education methods.

Elements of speech therapy.

METHODS OF INSTRUCTION	Lecture, discussion, didactic film, reading assignments, quizzes, demonstrations, case studies, lesson online.
REQUIREMENTS AND ASSESSMENTS	Two tests during the term covering the texts and workshops (multiple choice; true- false statements; gapped sentences) One short presentation
GRADING SYSTEM	Success in this course depends on attending class regularly, actively participating in class, and taking thorough notes.
