Volume 6 – call for papers

The Editorial Board is accepting articles, reports and reviews for Vol. 6 of the "Educatio Nova" yearbook, whose leading theme is:

CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS IN SCIENTIFIC DISCOURSE.

Possible areas of investigation are enumerated in Newsletter 3, which is available on the UMCS website and on the "Educatio Nova" Facebook profile. An invitation to publish is extended to authors representing various disciplines and research centres, as the journal is a forum for multifaceted and interdisciplinary reflection on current phenomena and issues.

Due to the current epidemic situation, the deadline for paper submission to Volume 6 has been extended **to July 31, 2020.**

The Editorial Board asks authors to ensure that the submitted texts meet the publishing criteria. Detailed guidelines for authors were published in Newsletter 4. Texts which fail to meet the publishing criteria may be rejected.

Volume 7 – leading theme

The Editorial Board invites proposals for the leading theme of Volume 7, to be published in 2022. The yearbook is a multidisciplinary platform for exchange of thoughts as well as for integration of researchers from Poland and abroad interested in various aspects of education and representing various disciplines, primarily in the field of humanities, mainly literature and linguistics, and social sciences, especially pedagogy and psychology.



From 1st December 2019 "Educatio Nova" has a Facebook profile where we share the statistics from the fanpage currently containing articles on the topic of the changes and perspectives of modern-day education from the 3rd volume of our journal.

The number of regular followers is systematically rising, with the current number at 101. An overwhelming majority of the internet users that visit our profile are women (72%), and the visitors from outside Poland – The United Kingdom, Brazil, Ireland, Ukraine, Turkey, Spain or Hungary – are a testimony to the journal's international scope. Our profile is read in, among others, Lublin, Łodz, Krakow, Cáceres, Burdur and São Paulo. We are also noting an increase in the regular posts, averaging above 128 persons, and hope to see the numbers rising.
