- queer discourses
- narratives of conflict and resolution in various media
- raising awareness, fighting propaganda
- (non-)discrimination laws
- between and betwixt privileges
- words and art against/for oppression
- doing gender, seeing gender, being gender

All presentations will be released on the conference website during the week of the conference and each is going to have their live Q&A via Discord. We will accept presentations in the form of: text with pictures (about 1400 words and no more than 10 pictures), video, or PowerPoint with voice-over. Please indicate which form of presentation you would like in your proposal as well the time zone you will be presenting from (some of the conference will be delivered synchronously).

Presenters will be invited to submit their papers to a peer-reviewed journal to be published by September 2021.
