Volume 5 „EN” – preview

The latest volume of “Educatio Nova” to be published soon

deals with a number of issues from a broadly defined field of axiology, placing an emphasis on the concept of a value as a subject of international, interdisciplinary and, specifically, education-oriented studies [from The Introduction].

The Subject Editor divided the content of the annual into three self-complementary sections. The first, *Axiology and Polish Language Education*, is of a general character. The second entitled *Reading across Contexts* introduces papers discussing different literary works with reference to instructed settings and value systems. The third, *Between Cultures*, explores the topic of values in the context of intercultural competence and selected axiological facets of a teaching and learning process. The Contents will be published in the subsequent newsletter.

Prof. dr Pau Freixa Terradas

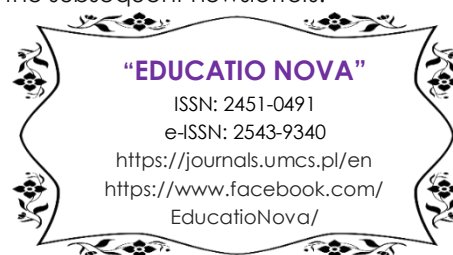

He published, among others, *Recepció de l'obra de Witold Gombrowicz a l'Argentina i configuració de la seva imatge a l'imaginari cultural argentí* (The Reception of the Work of Witold Gombrowicz and its Role in Developing the Mental Imagery in the Mindset of the Argentines, *Odbiór dzieła Witolda Gombrowicza w Argentynie i kształtowanie się jego obrazu w wyobraźni zbiorowej Argentczyków*) (2008) and two chapters in a monograph: *Historia de la literatura universal* (Eds. M. de Riquer, J.M. Valverde, 2009). He translated into Spanish and Catalan, *inter alia*, the works of Gombrowicz (*Pornografia*, *Dramaty*, *Kronos*, in cooperation with Bożena Zaboklicka), Ryszard Kapuściński (*The Emperor: Downfall of an Autocrat*) or Dorota Masłowska (*Dramaty*).
