

## § 7

### **Sanctions for violating the regulations**

1. In the case of user who violated the regulations, UMCS Internet Network Administration Officers may applied the following sanctions, depending on the severity of the breach (applied in order):
  - 1) administrator's warning in a written form;
  - 2) UMCS Internet Network Administration Officer's warning in a written form;
  - 3) temporary loss of the UMCS Computer Network user's permissions (for 1 month);
  - 4) temporary loss of the UMCS Computer Network user's permissions (for 3 months);
  - 5) temporary loss of the UMCS Computer Network user's permissions (for 1 semester);
  - 6) temporary loss of the UMCS Computer Network user's permissions (for the whole academic year);
  - 7) permanent loss of the UMCS Computer Network user's permissions.
2. A user who violated the regulations or the legal order is obliged to submit the written explanation to the UMCS Internet Network Administration within 7 days from the date of receiving the request appropriate to the occurred violation. Failure in submitting the explanations leads to the loss of the user's rights until the required explanations are provided.
3. A user has a right to submit the written complaint against the applied sanctions. The complaint should contain the explanation of the circumstances in which the regulations were violated.
4. UMCS Internet Network Administration may process the complaint within 14 days. No response within this time is tantamount with maintaining the sanctions.
5. The application of the sanctions mentioned in paragraph 1 does not exclude liability resulting from the General Data Protection Regulation and separate provisions, in particular resulting from the Criminal Code, Civil Code, Labor Code, The Act on Copyright and Related Rights and the Higher Education Act.
