

"WHAT SCIENCE LOOKS LIKE" COMPETITION RULES

§ 1 THE COMPETITION ORGANIZER

- The competition is organized by the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer" or "MCSU". The Organizer's address: Maria Curie-Sklodowska University in Lublin Plac Marii Curie-Skłodowskiej 5 20-031 Lublin, Poland

§ 2 THE GOAL AND THE OBJECT OF THE COMPETITION

- The aim of the competition is to select the best graphic design (hereinafter referred to as the "project") – the prototype of the mascot of the Lublin Science Festival, hereinafter referred to as the "Festival" or "LSF".
- 2. The mascot will be used for identification and advertising purposes and will be the trademark of the Festival.
- 3. The project should provide for the possibility of producing it as a mascot.
- 4. The competition is open and international.
- 5. The competition is aimed at children, primary and secondary school students, students and other adults, hereinafter referred to as the "participant".

§ 3 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

- 1. The participant should, within the time limit specified in § 4, section 1 of this Regulation, make a project and send it through the application form available at www.umcs.pl
- 2. The participant may submit a maximum of one project.
- 3. The project can be made in any technique, it must be the participant's own work, not previously published, not presented at other competitions. Submitting a project is tantamount to accepting these Regulations.
- 4. Submitted works, after the end of the competition, may be published on the websites and in social media regarding the Festival and public universities in Lublin and the Lublin City Office, which are co-organizers of the Festival.
- 5. The project should be sent to the Organizer in a JPG or PNG format enabling the presentation of the graphic version of the mascot. The project should display the full look of the LSF mascot.

§ 4 DURATION OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The competition starts on the 11th of January, 2021 after the announcement by the Rector of MCSU and lasts until the 7th of March 2021, while the activities related to granting and collecting the award will end not later than till the 24th of September, 2021.
- 2. Only those works which will be sent through the application form available at www.umcs.pl by the 6th of March 2021 will qualify for the competition.

§ 5 DETERMINATION OF WINNER

- Winner will be selected by the selection board appointed by the Vice-Rector for Science and International Cooperation of the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University, composed of:
- a) Director of MCSU Promotion Centre,
- b) MCSU representative,

- c) representative of the University of Life Sciences in Lublin,
- d) representative of the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin,
- e) representative of the Medical University of Lublin,
- f) representative of the Lublin University of Technology,
- g) representative of the Lublin City Office, hereinafter referred to as the "Committee".
- 2. The Committee allows for the possibility of inviting experts in an advisory capacity as a guest.
- 3. The chairman of the Committee is the Director of MCSU Promotion Centre.
- 4. The Committee selects the Deputy Chairman from among its members, responsible for the preparation of protocols and documentation of the competition.
- 5. The chairman submits the protocol from the competition for the Rector of MCSU with the project eligible for funding in order to accept the costs of its implementation.
- 6. The winning project will be selected by the Committee on the basis of a subjective assessment of the submitted works. When choosing the best project, the Committee will be guided by criteria such as:
- a) compliance of the project with the competition task,
- b) utility values, including the possibility of duplicating the design on promotional materials of the 17th LSF,
- c) creativity and originality of the design,
- d) a reflection of the values and mission of the Festival.
- 7. Only projects that meet the formal requirements of the Competition and submitted within the time limit specified in § 4 section 1. Any projects sent after the above-mentioned deadline or with an incorrectly completed form for these Regulations, will not be accepted by the Organizer and will not take part in the Competition.
- 8. The results of the Competition will be announced on the website www.umcs.pl and www.festiwal.lublin.pl and on the social media of the Festival at the latest by 31 March 2021.
- 9. The winner of the competition will be informed about its outcome by e-mail or

- 10. The Organizer reserves the right not to select a winner.
- 11. The Organizer may cancel the competition at any time without giving any reason. If the winner is selected, the author of the project transfers to the Organizer all economic copyrights, in accordance with the principles set out in the statement on free transfer of economic copyrights, which constitutes Appendix No. 2 to these Regulations.

ξ6 PRIZES

- 1. The Committee will select one Competition Winner from among the submitted projects.
- 2. The Organizer will award one prize in the Competition in the amount of 2000 zl (two thousand zloty 00/100) gross.
- 3. The Organizer, by informing about the results of the Competition, will inform about the date and method of receiving the prize.

§7 PERSONAL DATA

- 1. Participants' personal data will be collected and processed by the Organizer in accordance with The Act of 10 May 2018 on the Protection of Personal Data [unified text – journal of laws of 2019, item 1781].
- 2. The administrator of personal data collected during the Competition is the Organizer. Personal data provided by Participants will be processed only for the purposes of the Competition on the terms set out in these Regulations and in the legal regulation.
- 3. Participants' personal data will be processed only for the purposes of related to:
- a) organising the Competition,
- b) selecting the winners,
- c) awarding prizes,
- d) the complaint procedure.

- 4. Providing their personal data by Participants is voluntary, but necessary to receive an award in the Competition.
- 5. Participants have the right to access and correct their data.

§ 8 FINAL PROVISIONS

- 1. The provisions of these Regulations are interpreted by the Commission on their own initiative or at the written request of the person taking part in the competition.
- 2. Regulations of the "What science looks like" enters into force on 11 January 2021.
- 3. The Organizer reserves the right to changes to the content of these Regulations.
- 4. All appendices constitute an integral part of these Regulations.

Appendices:

- 1. Consent of the legal representative/legal guardian to participate in the competition and the processing of personal data (in the case of participants who are minors or do not have full legal capacity to perform acts in law).
- 2. Declaration of free transfer to the Organizer of economic copyrights.
- 3. Declaration of consent to the processing of personal data.
