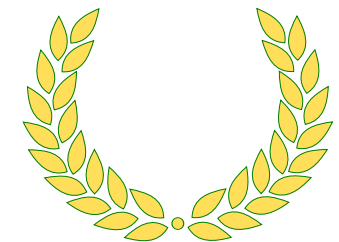

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Training ladder - step by step

Experts train mentors (group 1A)

9 experts, 18 mentors



Mentors (1A) train academic teachers (trainers - group 1B)

Training of 120 academic teachers (1B)

12-hour on-line training covering 4 hours from each module (I-III), conduct by 2 mentors simultaneously

40 lecturers will be trained in each country

For example: 3 training sessions (12h) conduct by 6 mentors (2 per session) with 13, 13 and 14 teachers in the group (total 40)



Training of 1200 students of pedagogical fields



400 students from each country participate in the online classes of trained lecturers (from group 1B).



Training of 60 school teachers

School teachers (20 teachers from each country) from schools that cooperate with Partner Universities.

School teachers will take part in the 6-hour training (2 hours from each block I-III) conducted simultaneously by two academic lecturers (trainers from 1B).
