- 1. Following § 13, section 2 of the Regulations of the Doctoral School in Social Sciences at the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University, a PhD student is obliged to prepare in cooperation with the supervisor an individual research plan. This plan should be prepared at the end of the first year of doctoral studies, approved by the Scientific Council of the Institute of Socio-Economic Geography and Spatial Management and submitted to the Director of the Doctoral School in Social Sciences at Maria Curie-Skłodowska University not later than in September of that year.
- 2. The individual research plan should include the following activities related to the preparation of the thesis and the presentation of the research results:

	c) the information on planned international cooperation;		
	d) the information on planned activities related to applying for external funds;

	3) Submission of the Individual Research Plan to the Director of the Institute of		
	Socio-Economic Geography and Spatial Management in time to be presented and

	4) Submission to the Director of the Institute of Social-Economic Geography and		
	Spatial Management the declaration of being acquainted with the document		
	entitled "Detailed rules of conducting mid-term evaluation at the Doctoral School		
	of Social Sciences, Maria Curie-Skłodowska University".		
	5) Slubmission of the approved Individual Research Plan to the Director of the		
	Doctoral School of Social Sciences, Maria Curie-Skłodowska University.
