

COMPETITION RULES "CATCH THE MOMENT IN SCIENCE"

§ 1 THE COMPETITION ORGANIZER

- The competition is organized by the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin, hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer" or "UMCS-Uniwersytet Marii Curie-Skłodowskiej". The Organizer's address: Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin Plac Marii Curie-Skłodowskiej 5 20-031 Lublin, Poland

§ 2 THE PURPOSE AND THE SUBJECT OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The aim of the competition is to show through photography the development of science, with particular emphasis on the impact of technological progress on people's everyday lives.
- 2. The competition is international in nature.
- 3. The competition is aimed at adults (35+) from the Republic of Poland and abroad, hereinafter referred to as "participant".

§ 3 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION

- 1. Within the time limit specified in § 4 sec. 1 of these Regulations, the participant should create and submit a piece of work to the Organizer through the application form available at www.umcs.pl
- 2. The participant may submit a maximum of one project.
- 3. The work can be finished in any technique, and it must be the participant's own work, not previously published, not presented at other competitions. Submitting a work is tantamount to accepting these Regulations.
- 4. After the end of the competition, submitted projects/work may be published on the website and social media channels concerned with the Festival and public universities in Lublin and the Lublin City Hall, which are co-organizers of the Festival.
- 5. The work should be sent to the Organizer in JPG. The maximum file size allowed is 10 MB.

§ 4 DURATION OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The Competition starts on 30.07.2021 after the announcement by the Rector of the UMCS and lasts until 12.09.2021, with the activities related to awarding and collecting the prize being completed by 24.09.2021 at the latest.
- 2. Only those works submitted by 12.09.2021 via the application form available at www.umcs.pl will qualify for the Competition.

§ 5 DETERMINATION OF THE WINNER

1. The competition winner will be selected by the Competition Commission appointed by the UMCS Vice-Rector for Research and International



Cooperation, composed of:

- a) Director of the UMCS Promotion Centre,
- b) A representative of UMCS,
- c) A representative of the University of Life Sciences,
- d) A representative of the John Paul II Catholic University of Lublin,
- e) A representative of the Medical University of Lublin,
- f) A representative of the Lublin University of Technology,
- g) A representative of the Lublin City Hall hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".
- 2. The Committee accepts the possibility of inviting experts in an advisory capacity as a guest.
- 3. The Chairperson of the Committee is the Director of the UMCS Promotion Centre.
- 4. The Committee selects the Deputy Chairperson from among its members, responsible for preparing the competition's minutes and other documentation.
- 5. The Chairperson presents the minutes of the competition to the UMCS Rector
- 6. The Committee will select the winning entries based on a subjective assessment of the submitted entries. In selecting the best works, the Commission will use criteria such as:
 - a) the conformity of the photograph with the competition aim and objective,
 - b) the description of the photograph taken,
 - c) the photographs ability to showcase highest value in terms of dissemination, promotion and popularisation of science and scientific research in society.
- 7. Only works that meet the competition's formal conditions and submitted within the time limit specified in § 4, sections 1, will be considered. Any works sent after the above-mentioned deadline or an incorrectly completed form for these Regulations will not be accepted by the Organizer and will not participate in the competition.
- 8. The results of the competition will be announced on the website www.umcs.pl and www.festiwal.lublin.pl and in the Festival's social media by 15th September 2021, at the latest.

- 9. The winner of the competition will be informed about its outcome by e-mail or by phone.
- 10. The Organizer reserves the right not to select the winner.
- 11. The Organizer may cancel the competition at any time without giving any reason.

§ 6 PRIZES

- 1. The Competition committee will choose one winner of the competition from among the submitted works.
- 2. The Organiser will award a material prize, which amounts to a total of 2000 PLN (gross) for the winner (two thousand zlotys gross)
- 3. The Organiser, while announcing the results of the competition, will provide background information about the date and manner of presenting the award.

ξ7 PERSONAL DATA

- 1. Participants' personal data will be collected and processed by the Organizer in conformity with the Act of 10th May 2018 to protect personal data (i.e. Journal of Laws of 2019, item 1781).
- 2. The Organizer is the administrator of personal data collected during the competition. Participants' personal data will be processed only for the Competition to the extent and on the terms set out in these Regulations and the law.
- 3. The administrator of personal data collected during the Competition is the Organizer. Participants' personal data will be processed only for the Competition on the terms set out in these Regulations and the legal regulation.
- 4. The Participants' personal data will be processed only for the formal purposes of:
- a) organising the competition,
- b) selecting the winner,

- c) awarding and issuing prizes,
- d) the complaint procedure.
- 5. Providing their personal data by the Participants is voluntary but necessary to receive the competition prize.
- 6. Participants have the right to access and correct their data.

- 1. The Committee interprets these Regulations' provisions on its own initiative or at the written request of a person participating in the competition.
- 2. The regulations of the competition "Catch the moment in science" shall enter into force on 30.07.2021.
- 3. The Organizer reserves the right to change the content of these Regulations.
- 4. All attachments constitute an integral part of these Regulations.
