ACCOMODATION & THE CAMPUS

The UMCS campus is a complex of buildings in close proximity to the city centre. It consists of the UMCS dormitories, private dorms, the UMCS Centre of Physical Culture, the Academic Centre of Culture and Media "Chatka Zaka" UMCS and the university-owned Academic Park. Main Library and University canteen.

The cost of accommodation in our UMCS dormitories is between 85-155 EUR per month bearing in mind exchange rates. Students arriving in Lublin also can choose to rent a private apartment instead of living in a dormitory, prices range from 170 EUR for a room in shared flat to 350 EUR for a whole flat (per month).



FACILITIES AND BENEFITS

- ◆ **Welcome Centre** – A multinational team whose goal is to implement tasks related to the adaptation and integration of foreign students into the UMCS culture and family
- ◆ **The Knowledge and Technology Transfer Centre of UMCS** – Responsible for facilitation and practical application of research results
- ◆ **Analytical Centre for Technologically Advanced Environmentally Friendly Research (ECOTECH COMPLEX)** – Equipped with 14 laboratories covering an area of 2600 m² and a so-called “clean room” for research which requires the highest standards of sanitation
- ◆ **The UMCS Botanical Garden** – Established 1965; The main task of this scientific-didactic unit is active protection

of 7000 endangered species of plants. The garden is also a place of leisure and recreation

- ◆ **Academic Centre of Culture and Media UMCS Chatka Żaka** – The integration centre for the creative communities and venue for almost all artistic domains such as (music, theatre, film visual arts, literature, radio)
