

Welcome Centre

ACCOMODATION & THE CAMPUS

The UMCS campus is a complex of buildings in close proximity to the city centre. It consists of the UMCS dormitories, private dorms, the UMCS Centre of Physical Culture, the Academic Centre of Culture and Media UMCS Chatka Żaka and the university-owned Academic Park. Main Library and University canteen.

The cost of accommodation in our UMCS dormitories is between 93–176 EUR per month bearing in mind exchange rates. Students arriving in Lublin also can choose to rent a private apartment instead of living in a dormitory, prices range from 200 EUR for a room in shared flat to 450 EUR for a whole flat (per month).
