The procedure of applying for on-campus accommodation for 2024/25 academic year starts on Thursday, September 5, 2024 and lasts until Thursday, September 12, 2024.


During the **third round of applications** the following groups of students can apply:


1) students admitted to:

- I-year of the first-cycle study programmes (3-year programmes),
- I-year of the second-cycle study programmes (2-year programmes),
- I-year of the engineer's degree study programmes (3,5-year programmes),
- I-year of the long-cycle study programmes (5-year programmes),
- 2) I-year doctoral students.
- 3) II-year, and III-year students of the first-cycle study programmes,
- 4) II-year students of the second-cycle study programmes,
- 5) II, III, IV and IV-year students of the long-cycle study programmes,
- 6) II, III and IV-year doctoral students.

Applications can be submitted by persons who did not apply for accommodation in the I and II round of applications.


To complete the application for a place in one of the UMCS residence halls, log into USOSweb, go to the **Applications (Wnioski)** module in the **COMMON SECTION** tab and click "fill in" on the menu next to the **housing application**. For easier navigation, set the website language to English.





To fill in your application, please provide necessary details on subsequent pages.

On **page 3** you will be asked to verify the data you entered.



On **page 4**, enter the distance from your permanent place of residence to the University (a), that is Maria Curie-Skłodowska Square, following the existing traffic routes. You may use Google Maps to calculate the distance between two or more points. **International students and international PhD students should provide the distance between the UMCS and their address of residence in their home country, outside Poland.**

When entering the distance, do not include any periods or commas after whole numbers. The correct format is, e.g. 1000 km, not 1.000/1,000 km. Numbers entered incorrectly will be converted to a distance of 1 km, which may disqualify the student's application for a place.



In the next box, state your household monthly income per 1 person for the previous tax year (b). For instance, when applying for a University-provided accommodation for the academic year 2024/2025 you should enter your household monthly income for the year 2023.

To calculate the monthly income per person, add the income of each family member, divide the total by the number of months over which the income was earned (12), and then divide by the number of people in the family.

Income should be calculated following the same regulations as apply when calculating the maintenance grant. Read more in "Regulations on Student Benefits of the Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin"; chapter 3, § 25.



At the bottom of the page you can indicate additional circumstances that may affect what kind of place are you assigned (c). These details should be included in your application. Persons with disabilities, single parents, student marriages, half-orphans and orphans need to present documents proving their circumstances (certificate stating the degree of disability, a copy of child's birth certificate, a copy of marriage certificate or/and a copy of parent's death certificate).


Attention! Students and PhD students whose household monthly income per person exceeds the income threshold that allows them to apply for the maintenance grant may also file housing applications.

On **page 5**, you can specify your next of kin, such as **your child or spouse**, for whom you are requesting additional accommodation. Once your application is considered, you will either receive all the requested places or none at all.




Page 7 includes a description of each dormitory, along with contact details and a list of furniture and equipment available in the rooms. You can also find the detailed information about each dormitory on the website:




On **page 8** you should indicate the dormitories you would like to be accommodated in. State your preference by **clicking and dragging your choices to the relevant positions** in the ranking list. Each student or PhD student is allowed to apply for a place in any of the available dormitories.

During the second round of application, **students cannot apply for accommodation in "Helios" and "Grześ" Residence Halls.** The possibility of applying for accommodation in "Helios" or "Grześ" shall be provided in a separate announcement.



On **page 9**, there is a section where you can state your reasons for requesting dormitory accommodation. Applicants who are visually impaired, use a wheelchair, or walk with crutches should note this information here.




To complete your application, click **REGISTER** on the last page. After doing so, you will no longer be able to edit your application. Your application, as registered, will be processed by the coordinator from the Office for Student Affairs and Support Office for Students with Disabilities of the Centre for Education and Studies Management.

ATTENTION! Applications that were not registered will not be considered.



Remember to **monitor the status of your application on a regular basis**, as it may be returned to you for correction or further information. If your application has been successfully submitted, its status will change from "**Registered**" to "**Pending Verification**".




ATTENTION! It is not necessary to print out and submit a paper form of your application.

You will receive an email notification once your application has been considered. The results will be visible in the details of your application in the USOSweb. If the name of a dormitory appears in the "Assigned dormitory" box, you have been allocated a place. If it says "None", you were not awarded any place of residence in a dormitory.

The choice of assigned places must be confirmed in the USOSweb by <u>26</u> August, <u>2024</u> by clicking "Confirm". The status of your application will change from "Accepted" to "Confirmed". Moreover, you are obliged to pay the deposit/booking fee in the amount of 400 PLN no later than 30 August <u>2024</u>.

If you do not complete these steps before the specified deadlines, your application will be rejected and you will not be able to reclaim the previously allocated place.



If you wish to resign from the assigned place in a dormitory, **you are obliged** to report this fact in the USOSweb **by clicking the "Cancel" button**. Following this operation, the status of your application will change to "Abandoned". Once you have given up your assigned place in the USOSweb system, this action cannot be reversed.
