

Guidelines for preparing a text

1. Texts submitted to “Consensus – Student Scientific Journals” should be written in either Polish or a foreign language.
2. The submission must include the author’s full name, academic title or degree, place of study/work, and email address.
3. The title of the article should be provided in both Polish and English.
4. “Streszczenie” [Summary] in Polish and “Summary” in English should each be no longer than 100 words, outlining the research aims, assumptions, findings, and conclusions.
5. “Słowa kluczowe” [Keywords] in Polish and “Keywords” in English should reflect the essence of the study and align with accepted categories within the relevant research field (between 3 and 8 keywords).
6. Texts should be prepared in Microsoft Word, using Times New Roman font, size 12, with 1.5 line spacing. They should be submitted electronically to the Editorial Board. The Editorial Board reserves the right to make editorial changes.
7. Articles should generally be divided into sections with appropriate headings.
8. Articles, including footnotes, should not exceed 22 standard pages, review articles should be limited to 8 standard pages, and research reports should range between 3 and 6 standard pages. The Editorial Board reserves the right to make cuts where necessary.
9. Each table, figure, or graph should be numbered sequentially, have a title, and include a source. The number and title should be placed above the illustration, while the source should be provided below. Tables and graphs should be editable.
10. Foreign language insertions should be italicised. Quotations should be enclosed in quotation marks (without italics). Book titles in the text should be italicised without quotation marks. In footnotes, only book and article titles should be italicised.
11. When citing websites, the full title of the webpage, URL, and date of access must be provided.
12. Footnotes should be placed at the bottom of the page.
13. Bibliographic references in footnotes should follow the formatting guidelines below:
